Murray Richter is a Dallas-based author whose middle-grade fictional debut novel entitled *Lucky Rocks* is the winner of the 2017 Gertrude Warner First in Class Award from the Chanticleer Book Reviews and the Silver Award winner in the 2019 Feathered Quill Book Awards Program for the Backlist - Children's YA category. His second novel, published in 2021 and entitled *Fishing For Luck*, is the Silver Award winner in the 2021 Reader's Choice Award for the Best Children's Book (Ages 7-10+), a 2021 BookLife Prize Quarter Finalist, a 2021 Feathered Quill Bronze Award winner for both the Young Readers and Book Cover Design categories, and a Short-List finalist for the Mark Twain Awards in the 2021 Chanticleer International Book Review Competition and the Grand Prize Winner of the Gertrude Warner Award for Middle-Grade Readers also from the Chanticleer International Book Reviews. Mr. Richter has also mediated the Explore Horizons annual writing competition for young writers in 2018-2019.

Furthermore, Mr. Richter has such a passion for inspiring children to read and write that he is available for a modest honorarium to come read at your school, participate in a writer's workshop and deliver presentations as a visiting author. He would also love to participate in book signings for your students if they wish to purchase a copy of *Lucky Rocks* or *Fishing For Luck*. Mr. Richter can answer questions about the writing process, give tips to young writers, and speak about the profession of an author. He also seeks to engage his young readers in outdoor learning environments by hosting fishing and cast net lessons in the Dallas area and holding photo contests on his Facebook page.






